




Wednesday Evening Children's and Youth Ministry!

WHISTLING & WHITTLING

My husband whistled all the time. Along with whistling, he loved to whittle. One day I stepped out onto the front porch and saw Ted whistling and whittling. As we visited I watched him take a small block of wood and turn it into a beautiful bird.

Ted: You wanna learn? It's easy. Me: Really? It doesn't look easy.

Ted: It's simple. Here's you a block of wood; here's my best pocket knife. Now, all you have to do is take off the parts that don't look like a bird.

My surprise and confusion made us both laugh. Of course, he then lovingly taught me the do's and don'ts of whittling — go layer by layer, don't cut big chunks; use the right tools and take your time on feathers and small details; trust your eye to create something beautiful.

I use some of these rules in my life even now. Bible Study, Worship Service, Sunday School, my own quiet time — all these things help me "look" more like Jesus. We have been given living words that show us how a follower of Jesus should live. Galatians 5:22-23 says "But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control." Guess what this is? A very distinct map of who I should be. So, if I am impatient, whittle it away. If I am not being kind and no love is being shown, whittle those times down to zero. If I lack joy and have no peace, I ask Him in prayer how I am to whittle that out of my life and regain joy and peace. I am called to be like Jesus. So I will keep on whittling away as I keep the sound of Ted's whistling close to my heart.
