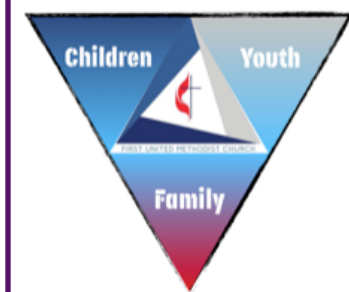

Wednesday Evening Children's and Youth Ministry
Wednesday evenings continue to grow. Mary Launey continues to facilitate the kindergarten thru 2nd grade group – we also have a few pre-kindergarten children that attend. Laura Moses works with the 3rd thru 5th grade group and I continue with the youth group. We are always looking to expand this ministry; all children are welcome.

Wednesdays start at 5:00 with activity time. For drop off convenience parents can drop their children off at the gym doors (near the Church office), just pull into the circular driveway and we will meet you at the door. At 6:00 we all share a meal, then move on to lessons from 6:30 until 7:30.

Wednesday evenings ministries will continue through the month of June. We will not meet in July as our focus will be on Summer Camps and VBS. We will start back up the first week in August.

Sunday Early Worshipers

Every Sunday from 9:00–9:45 our Early Worshipers meet. All children in grades K–12 are invited to attend. We provide light breakfast foods and juice to get the morning started. This time helps your child prepare for Worship and the lessons that they will learn during Children's Church. You can drop off as early as 8:45 if you are attending one of the adult morning classes.

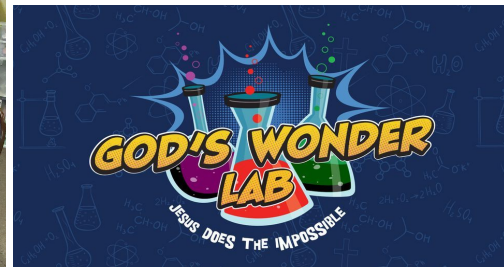
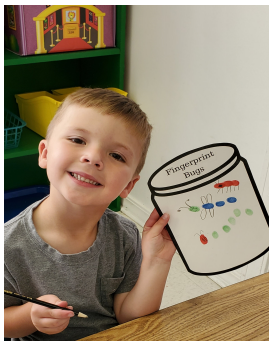
Children's Church

First, heart-felt thanks to EACH of you for EVERY prayer, encouragement, card, meal, money, concern, message, text and phone call! I have used each one during my weekly times of travel and treatment. And now, I am able to share the answers we were given. The Neuro surgeon explained it like this. Make a fist. Your fist represents the tumor. Imagine your fist is a bee's nest; the bees inside are active and cause the nest to grow. The proton radiation killed those bees. The nest remains but can NEVER GROW again!! Amazing news: The tumor is benign and stable. It cannot grow. Yay, God!!!! Already I have better vision, balance, and less headaches. There was some damage to the area affecting the left eye and short term memory. The fatigue brought on by radiation will slowly go away. Medicine changes and new glasses will help. A schedule that includes planned rest is suggested as well as regular follow up appointments.

Prayers were answered with a "yes" from God, our Healer. I get to return to playing the organ in June. I have seen God's work in my life every day. My family has been drawn closer as they have cared for me. He has provided at every turn, in every way. I praise and thank you, Lord, for Your mercy, Your provision and Your love.

OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD

This is our fifth year participating in the Operation Christmas Child global mission. Our goal again is to fill 125 shoeboxes for children between the ages of 5 and 9. As in the past, we will collect specific items each month throughout the summer with October being the final month.

The congregation may choose items tagged on the small Christmas trees in the sanctuary or office, where collection bins will be provided. Or members may choose from items published each month in the newsletter. Items must be small enough to allow all items to fit into the shoebox. Monthly categories are: **June** – Toys, **July** – School Supplies, **August** – Clothing and Accessories, **September** – Hygiene Items, and **October** – donations for shipping and training costs (for in-country leaders who present the gospel to the children).
