On the playground at school, I was often called over to settle a dispute. Almost 100% of these disputes were caused by hurtful words. But praising both sides for their unique strengths seemed to work wonders. My parents encouraged this. They showed me Matthew 5:9 "Blessed are the peacemakers for they will be called children of God (NIV)." As I got older, this became more and more a part of who I wanted to be for Jesus. I learned in Proverbs 15:1 "A soft word turns away wrath but a harsh word stirs up anger." So where did this upbringing take me? Surprisingly enough, it allows me to decide my attitude. It plays a big role in how I decide to react. I may run into sharp criticism from someone who is dealing with something very hard in life. My kindness is how Jesus tells me to react. Kindness is something our world is desperate for. Every kindness counts. Let's join together to be kinder. Heavenly Father, I am loved, chosen, purposed, and forgiven. Help me live out these truths. Thank you, Lord. Amen.
