
Congregation: Let these branches be for us signs of his victory, and grant that we who bear them in his name may every hail him as our Lord, and follow him in the way that leads to eternal life.
















#### \*Affirmation of Faith























## Scripture Reading Matthew 21:1-16

As they approached Jerusalem and came to Bethphage on the Mount of Olives, Jesus sent two disciples, saying to them, "Go to the village ahead of you, and at once you will find a donkey tied there, with her colt by her. "Yes," replied Jesus, "have you never read, "From the lips of children and infants you, Lord, have called forth your praise'?"




