Pastor's Ponderings!

When I was in Junior High School, I remember my family and I getting up early one Sunday morning and going to the sunrise service for Easter. It was in the Sanctuary of the church. The usually bright place was very dark with only a few lights on. It matched the darkness of outside because the sun had not come up yet. I knew something was very different about this morning. This worship service “felt” so different. They had decorated a part of the front of the church (actually the part that had an exit door going out into the garden) to look like the garden tomb where Jesus had been laid. I eagerly waited for things to begin.

Soon, a woman (dressed like a Jew) from Jesus’ day, was wandering through the sanctuary. She kept looking around like she was afraid someone was following her. Much to her surprise, when she got to the tomb, the stone had been rolled away! She walked into the tomb (outside) and came back looking around again in stunned amazement. Jesus is gone! Who had taken Jesus’ body away? And then Jesus suddenly appeared! She rejoiced, while falling to his feet, praising God that he was alive!

I was totally caught up in the moment and overwhelmed with emotion of the joy that Jesus was truly alive! We went from feeling the heartache of Jesus death, to watching the fear of Mary, to the joy of knowing our Messiah was really alive! Each of us could feel the joy of the moment. Our Savior is alive!!! This truly is something we need to celebrate every year. I hope you choose to be a part of either one or both of our Sunday Easter services on April 9th. The sunrise service is at 6:40 AM at Wesley Church at 701 N. Texas Street. We will be outdoors (indoors if it is raining) so bring your chairs to watch the sun rise while we worship and celebrate the risen Son! Our regular service at 10 AM will still be in the main sanctuary on Shirley Street and live streaming also. The services will be different from each other. What a beautiful day it will be to worship our risen Savior together! Please check the newsletter for our other special services during Holy Week. There are special services from Palm Sunday, to noon lunch and devotionals Monday – Wednesday, a Maundy Thursday service and Good Friday meditation. Hope to see you there as we “travel” through Holy Week.
