



I was proposed to today. I guess I shouldn't have been quite so surprised; I've known him, now, for 3 years. Here's what happened: "Me: So who do you think you will marry when you grow up?" First, a look of surprise. Then he answered, "YOU, Grandma!!" Awwwww. He stole my heart with those two words!

The English language seems to use the word "love" very casually. For instance, we say we love boiled crawfish, we love our new car, we love our spoiled pets, or even a new pair of shoes.

However, when listing our favorite coffee, we are very specific: Do you want a cappuccino, an espresso, a skinny latte, or maybe iced caramel macchiato? Recently, Rev. Laraine gave examples of Greek names for different types of love. PHILIOS: deep comradely friendship that developed between soldiers who had fought side by side on the battlefield. Friends in your life are included as Philios. Not "friends" as on Facebook, though. They considered the love of a friend meant a bond of emotion or actions showing someone cared about you.

The most radical word for love is AGAPE — selfless love extended to all people, whether family members or distant strangers. C.S. Lewis referred to it as "gift love," the highest form of Christian love. I interpret this to mean those we show mercy to; those we want to tell about God and the ultimate sacrifice of Jesus' death for each of us.

So....."love" has many sides to it. I am rich in Philios love, friends who stand by me through thick and thin. I am saved by Agape love, requiring me to share this with others always. AND, I will always remember that a 3 year old's love was shown to me by a Marriage Proposal!!
