Hi Church Family,

Well, August is almost in the books as I write this. I do sincerely hope that the hottest days will be soon behind us. Also praying that we all start receiving some much needed rain soon. Only an inch or two at a time, of course!

Last month we placed an announcement about the Bible Study in September. There is one significant change! We will be back to meeting on Wednesdays instead of Tuesdays. Still having opportunities to participate at 11 a.m. or 6 p.m. The move is necessary for two reasons. One is my being back in school. The second is that we are bringing back Wednesday night meals as so many have requested! Beginning Wednesday, September 6<sup>th</sup>, dinner will be served between 5 and 5:45 p.m. The cost is \$7 per person or a cap of \$25. The exception is the children and youth who are participating in Wednesday night activities. We have always fed them for free, and we will continue to do so. People will have the opportunity to eat and then go to children's activities, Bible Study, or go home. To go plates will also be available. Please register that you are attending with a form that will be available on Sundays or call the office by noon on Monday. We need to have an idea so they know how much to cook! You can sign up for one Wednesday at a time or register for the month!

Your first readings for Bible Study will be related to the Jordan River and the Israelites. We will be meeting in the Upper Room. There will be pictures from my trip to Israel plus maps. Please try to read these before you come to class on the 6<sup>th</sup>:

- ♦ Joshua 3:1-17 Joshua crosses the Jordan
- ♦ 2 Kings 2:4-14 Elisha and Elijah at the Jordan
- ♦ Matthew 3:1-6 John baptizes people in the Jordan
- ♦ Matthew 3:13-17 Jesus is baptized

### Tiger Island Fire

I want to share a few words with you about the last couple of weeks. This church, YOU, have been the Body of Christ to this community, to each other and to this parish. You opened the building doors and welcomed 75 evacuees into our building and provided them a safe place to be, running water, AC, bathrooms, love, hugs, snacks, games, DVDs to watch, hygiene items and your prayers. You blessed them in church on Sunday beyond measure, and I think you have been blessed by them. This is what being in ministry is about.

As I write this, UMCOR is on the way in the morning to deliver cleaning buckets that we will be taking immediately to Merryville for a start, because people are going home to find their homes being filled with the smell of smoke and covered in ash dust. We are working on some special cleaning supplies to help with the smell of smoke. There may be more supplies down the road for others. We will be interviewing them about their needs, including AC filters to help filter out the smoke particles.

Matthew 25 says, "Come, you who are blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world, for I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, I was naked and you gave me clothing, I was sick and you took care of me, I was in prison and you visited me." There has been, and continues to be a need, and you have and are responding! God bless you for living out who Jesus calls us to be. You have lived out your mission statement also, "Central to DeRidder, Centered in Christ. Our Mission is to grow and serve in Christ." Well done, well done! Keep it going Church!!!

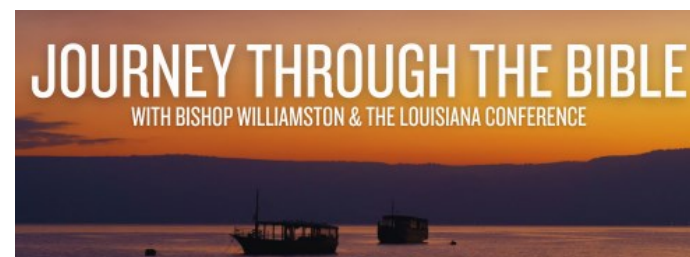

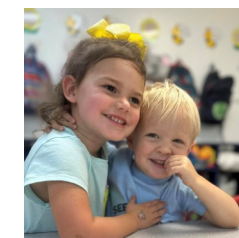

## From the Heart by Mary Allen

I have a good friend who checks on me often. She is the "safe friend", meaning I can share anything with her. This was our text exchange yesterday:

**Friend:** How are you doing? For real?

**Me:** Pretty good. This week has some long days in it. So...

this old(er) Piano Lady is hearing a strong call from my recliner to sit down and put my feet up. I end up in the recliner several times in between spending mornings with the grandkids, then going to work, along with sitting in line at the pharmacy, going to get the grocery pick-up, playing for choir practices and church services, feeding Pete-the-Horse and scratching his back (which I purposefully take time to do because being outside with any of my fur-babies fills me up when I'm on empty), and viewing every new 1st-Day-of-School shoes-supplies-backpacks-lunchboxes-socks, shirts and shorts, plus sundry other things!

**Friend:** Gosh...that IS a lot!

At this point I can read the living Word of God in Matthew 11:28: "Come to me, all you who labor and are heavily burdened, and I will give you rest." But I must, then, consider verse 30: "For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light." I must acknowledge that "His yoke" means sharing Jesus, reading His Word, staying in prayer & waiting to hear what His answer is. I am to be like Him and do His work. Perhaps not everything in my text above falls under that description. Therefore, my heart constantly asks God to shine through me. In every daily action, I want to represent Him with truth and
