We give thanks for neighbors who offer help in times of trouble, gentleness in the midst of pain, and acts of kindness during seasons of struggle.
























*Affirmation of Faith

the divine presence in our lives, whereby we are kept in perpetual remembrance of the truth of Christ, and find strength and help in time of need. We believe that this faith


should manifest itself in the service of love as set forth in the example of our leased Lord, to the end that the kingdom of God may come upon the earth. Amen.





















Scripture Reading: Jeremiah 23:1-6






