but the LORD rises upon you and his glory appears over you. Nations will come to your light, and kings to the brightness of your dawn.




Nations will come to your light, and kings to the brightness of your dawn. Congregation: We light this candle as a symbol of Christ our Hope. May the light sent from

God shine in the darkness to show us the way of salvation. O come, O come, Emanuel.

















*Affirmation of Faith














Scripture Reading Micah 5:2-4 Isaiah 7:14

Isaiah 11:1-6;12

Micah 5:2-5

"But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, though you are small among the clans of Judah, out of you will come for me one who will be ruler over Israel, whose origins are from of old, from ancient times. Therefore Israel will be abandoned until the time when she who is in labor bears a son, and the rest of his brothers return to join the Israelites. He will stand and shepherd his flock in the strength of the Lord, in the

majesty of the name of the Lord his God. And they will live securely, for then his greatness will reach to the ends of the earth.

Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign: The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and will call him Immanuel.

Isaiah 11:1-6;12

the Spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the Spirit of counsel and of might, the Spirit of the knowledge and fear of the Lord—and he will delight in the fear of the Lord.

He will not judge by what he sees with his eyes, or decide by what he hears with his ears; but with righteousness he will judge the needy, with justice he will give decisions for the poor of the earth.

He will strike the earth with the rod of his mouth; with the breath of his lips he will slay the wicked. Righteousness will be his belt and faithfulness the sash around his waist.

The wolf will live with the lamb, the leopard will lie down with the goat, the calf and the lion and the yearling together; and a little child will lead them.

He will raise a banner for the nations and gather the exiles of Israel; he will assemble the scattered people of Judah from the four quarters of the earth.
