## Pastor's Ponderings!

The Christmas of 2009 was one that is never to be forgotten. It was the first Christmas after our mother died. Everyone was coming to my home and church in Olney, TX. Dad came to stay a couple of weeks and was already with me. Everyone else was to come Christmas Eve day in time for the Christmas Eve service. Except...we got up and it was supposed to snow. It was only supposed to be a couple of inches. My gut feeling, the Holy Spirit, urged me to call everyone and to tell them to come now. I called and none of them seemed to think I was too crazy. Everyone made it... eventually. That light snow turned into a full-blown blizzard with ten inches in total falling! It got a little scary for some and very scary for my sister. There were times that she could barely see the car in front of her, but there was nowhere to stop. She and another guy even bumped fenders, but they both moved on and didn't even get out of the car. Literally, hundreds of people were stranded in gas stations and along major roads. Farmers with their tractors came to the rescue. Finally, my sister made it almost at dinner time absolutely exhausted from the stress. We were all safely together and so grateful. Much of the town lost power, but not at my house. Part of the group was supposed to sleep across town, but instead we all bedded down in every room possible with sleeping bags, air mattresses and cots added to the arrangements. Fifteen people and five dogs! And we had the best time ever, even while making a toast to Mom because we were together. We played and played in the snow. A white Christmas like we had never had before. So much laughter and joy as we celebrated being together and the birth of Christ. Mary and Joseph's life together was starting off in ways they could have never imagined. Likely ostracized in their own town because of Mary being pregnant before the wedding. A census being taken, which meant they had to travel with Mary pregnant. And she would even deliver the baby far away from home. There was no room in the inn. A stable is where they had to be. Yet, God provided every step of the way. And the family of God, the shepherds, even came to tell them about the good news from the angels and to celebrate the Savior's birth. They were never alone and it was glorious. God provides. We just have to open our eyes to see, feel, hear and experience the blessings. May you experience the same this Christmas season in you and your family's lives. Blessings! Laraine








## Methodist Children's Learning Center

The children have worked very hard on their Christmas music and will sing on Sunday, December 10. After that date we will not have choir practice until Wednesday, January 3.



From the Heart by Mary Allen




