Dulac Mission Trip 2024

Come discover Dulac. Meet the history, culture, and charm of this shrimping and fishing community situated on the waterways of Terrebonne Parish.

We will have a Mini Mission Trip on January 24-27. The team will do light construction/painting work for some residents that suffered hurricane damage, and also help with projects at the Dulac Community Center. Most of the tools and materials will be provided, but we will likely take several items with us.

Transportation will be available, and details determined by the size of our team. Sleeping accommodations are provided by the Dulac Community Center on site. We will rest in the beds that our team assembled this past Spring! We will use the bathrooms that our team worked on! The Center has a full kitchen that will allow us to prepare the team meals. Our team was fed extraordinarily well during our last trip.

Who is invited? What skills are required? We need people who are ready to discover the amazing opportunities to serve others with a Christian joy. There are many ways to serve! We need people who can paint and follow instructions for light construction. We need people who can make coffee and hug necks. We need people who can wash dishes and tell jokes. We need people who can take photos and lead us in a devotional. We need you, your cousin, your friend.

The cost is \$30 per person to cover food and transportation. Registration will open on January 2, 2024. Pray for this Mission Trip, and please ask the Hammerschmidts, the Beals, Laraine, and the many others who have been there for more information and encouragement.
